On May 14, 2014 at approximately 5:30 pm, the Kent County Sheriff's Department was dispatched to the 200 block of Vine ST within the Village of Caledonia on a report of a missing person.

Upon deputies arriving on scene, they spoke with family members of Wayne Anthony Miller an 88 year old Caledonia Village resident. Family members reported Miller suffers from the onset of Alzheimer's disease and can easily become confused. Family members stated Miller left his residence around 2:00 PM and had not returned.

Deputies confirmed Miller had stopped at a friend's residence in Allegan County after leaving his residence and was then last seen on 5/14/14 at approximately 5:30 PM at the Parkview Motel located 429 N. Broadway Hastings, MI.

Miller is further described as a white male, approximately 5'10", 180 lbs., brown eyes with gray balding hair. Miller was last seen wearing a black sweatshirt with a picture of the Mackinaw Bridge and black jeans.

At the time of his disappearance Miller was driving a 2014 Toyota Sienna minivan, bearing Michigan handicap plate 6337E6.
