UPDATE – OCTOBER 26, 2016

On October 23, 2016, the Kent County Sheriff Department responded to a shots fired complaint within the dormitory area of Davenport University. After an extensive investigation, detectives were able to develop a suspect in the shooting. On October 25, 2016, a warrant request was presented to the Kent County Prosecutor's Office who authorized the following four count warrant for **Paul Christopher Howard, B/M, DOB: 10/25/1992, from Lansing, MI** (*pictured below*).

- 1) Discharge Firearm in Building
- 2) Carrying a Concealed Weapon
- 3) Carrying a Weapon with Unlawful Intent
- 4) Felony Firearm 2nd


The Kent County Sheriff Department is requesting assistance in locating **Paul Christopher Howard**, who should be considered armed and dangerous.

On 10-23-2016, at approximately 2:30AM, deputies responded to a report of shots fired at Davenport University, in Caledonia Township, Kent County. The investigation revealed that four non-students were involved in an altercation with two students. During the altercation one of the non-students discharged a gun. No one involved in the altercation was shot. However a bullet did penetrate a wall and hit a student who was not involved. This student has been treated at a hospital and released. The investigation is ongoing. Names are not being released.
